Volunteer Code of Ethics

I. Rules of Conduct

- A. *Propriety*. The MomsBloom volunteer should maintain high standards of personal conduct.
- B. *Competence and Professional Development*. The MomsBloom volunteer should strive to learn more through readings, future trainings and other resources.
- C. *Integrity*. The MomsBloom volunteer should act in a professional manner at all times.

II. Ethical Responsibility to Families

- A. *Primacy of Families Interests*. MomsBloom volunteer's primary responsibility is to the family she serves.
- B. *Rights and Prerogatives of Families*. The MomsBloom volunteer should make every effort to foster maximum independence on the part of her family.
- C. *Confidentiality and Privacy*. The MomsBloom volunteer should respect the privacy of the family.
- D. *Obligation to Serve*. MomsBloom and MomsBloom volunteer should assist families seeking postpartum support either by providing services or making appropriate referrals.
- E. *Reliability*. When the MomsBloom volunteer agrees to work with a particular family, the obligation is to do so reliably, to the best of the volunteer's ability, for the term of the agreement.

III. Ethical Responsibility to MomsBloom Volunteers

- A. *Respect, Fairness and Courtesy*. The MomsBloom volunteer should treat other MomsBloom volunteers and staff with respect, courtesy, fairness and good faith.

IV. Ethical Responsibility to Society

- A. *Promoting Maternal and Child Welfare*. The MomsBloom volunteer should promote the general health of women and their babies and, whenever possible, that of their family and friends as well.
